As custodians of some of the UK's most valued natural environments, we recognise our responsibility to protect and enhance the landscapes, wildlife, habitats and natural resources that make our locations unique and form an important part of our guests' experience. We are committed to complying with relevant environmental legislation and regulatory requirements.

Our Environmental Policy applies to all activities undertaken by Verdant Parks and extends to our employees, contractors, customers and suppliers.

Environmental Commitments

Biodiversity and Environmental Stewardship

Verdant Parks is committed to protecting and enhancing biodiversity across our parks and surrounding environments. We will:

- Consider the impact of our activities on wildlife and natural habitats.
- Seek opportunities to protect and enhance biodiversity.
- Manage trees, woodland and green spaces responsibly.
- Support habitat conservation and environmental improvement projects where appropriate.
- Promote awareness of environmental stewardship amongst employees and guests.
- Ensure environmental considerations form part of site planning and operational activities

Resource Efficiency and Pollution Prevention

Verdant Parks is committed to using resources responsibly and preventing pollution arising from our activities. We will:

- Promote the efficient use of energy, water and other natural resources.
- Reduce waste through prevention, reuse, recycling and responsible disposal.
- Seek opportunities to improve resource efficiency across our operations.
- Prevent pollution through effective environmental controls and good operational practices.
- Minimise emissions, discharges and other environmental impacts where reasonably practicable.
- Encourage employees, contractors and visitors to support sustainable environmental practices.

Sustainable Procurement

Where reasonably practicable, Verdant Parks will work with suppliers, contractors and business partners who share our environmental values and support our sustainability objectives. Environmental performance, responsible sourcing, waste reduction and sustainable business practices will be considered as part of supplier selection and ongoing supplier management arrangements.

Roles and Responsibilities

Environmental responsibility is shared by everyone working for or on behalf of Verdant Parks.

- Directors and senior management are responsible for providing leadership and resources to support delivery of this policy.
- The Sustainability Team is responsible for supporting environmental programmes, performance monitoring and continuous improvement initiatives.
- Park management teams are responsible for implementing environmental arrangements at site level.

All employees are responsible for working in an environmentally responsible manner and supporting the achievement of Verdant Parks' environmental objectives.

Monitoring and Continuous Improvement

Verdant Parks will establish and periodically review environmental objectives and targets designed to improve environmental performance across the Group.

We will:

- Monitor environmental performance and sustainability initiatives.
- Measure progress against agreed objectives.
- Review environmental performance regularly.
- Identify opportunities for continual improvement.
- Support Green Tourism accreditation requirements and other recognised sustainability initiatives.
- Encourage innovation and best practice in environmental management.
